

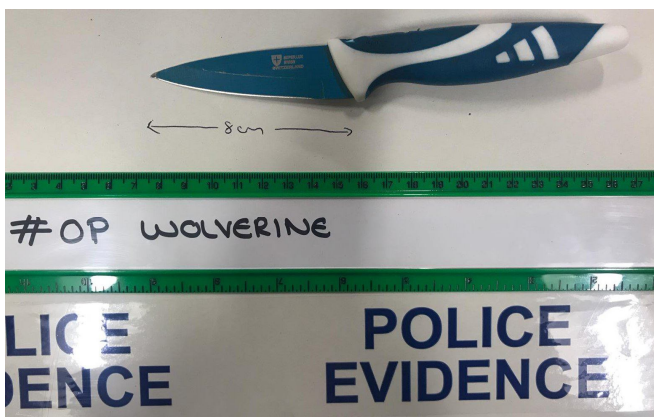
## Rob's Rapport

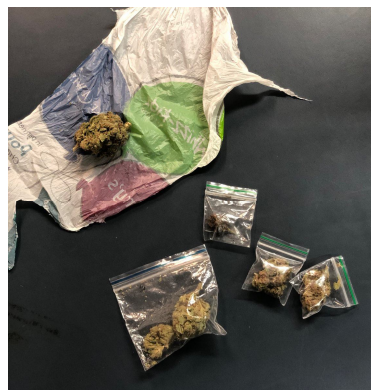
## Hillingdon's Beat

**Operation Wolverine.** The West Area now has a dedicated team of officers who go into our hotspots for violence and make their presence known. They have been having excellent results, using stop and search really effectively to get weapons off the streets. Earlier this month they stopped and searched someone in Hayes. Found on him was this knife and he was also wanted for burglary. One moire villain off the streets.
