Recent activity by the team

Your local ward officers have maintained their dedication to local residents & workers of Northwood by undertaking a number of local initiatives. Traffic operations continue in Northwood as part of our commitment to our community regarding your concerns over speeding vehicles. Offending motorists have been & continue to be prosecuted. Neighbourhood watch schemes have been increased significantly so helping to increase the safety & security of local resident's homes in Northwood. Police patrols have been maintained in & around the Northwood area focussing on areas where local people can see us but more importantly targeting local crime hot spot areas making sure all resident's are safe & well including all homes & vehicles.



Please bear in mind that the police station based at UXBRIDGE is now closed to the public. If you wish to attend a police station in Hillingdon then the station at HAYES is open to the public at all times. Consequently your ward officers are now staffing contact points twice per week for one hour within Northwood police station. Also listed on the newsletter are upcoming Coffee with a Copper sessions together with our crime prevention stalls which will continue on the Northwood ward. These are opportunities for our local residents & workers to speak with their local police officers on any matters of interest or concern.
