

## Northwood Remembrance Day Parade 11<sup>th</sup> November 2018

# PARADE ARRANGEMENTS

This is to advise the arrangements for the Northwood Remembrance Day Parade for 2018.

The Parade Organisers, NRA the Council and others have discussed and agreed the arrangements for 2018, summarised below, to promote a common understanding by those involved and the success of this year's parade:

- Road closures will be made on Maxwell Road at the junction with Green Lane and the junction with Murray Road and parking will be suspended on Maxwell Road between the junctions with Green Lane and Murray Road from the previous evening.
- A limited Police presence has been assured to ensure security that will make vehicle checks on traffic in Green Lane between Dene Rd. and Eastbury Rd. with some supplementary marshalling to assist the Police and public.
- There was a misunderstanding that until 2016 it had been agreed to close Green Lane for the Remembrance Parade, which would have required a Traffic Management Order. This would have been impractical due to the costs of diverting traffic and inconvenience to those who need to go about their daily business. However TfL has agreed that there will be no movement of buses during the 2 minutes silence.
- **We have been asked to pass on concerns from the Police about the actions to block Green Lane in 2016. These caused serious problems which must be not repeated.**
- The layout for the Parade will be provided to participants and will be arranged similarly to 2017 with the RBL Parade Commander stationed near the War Memorial.
- Participants in the Parade, Laying of Wreaths and the Service should report to the Parade Commander on arrival. They will be provided with access to their positions and arranged in separate areas from spectators.
- Spectators are asked to follow requests from the Organisers and use areas reserved for them, designated by hazard warning tapes and pedestrian barriers.
